

## Williams Executives to Speak at CERAWeek 2024

Senior executives from Williams will join global energy leaders at the world's preeminent energy conference, March 18-22 in Houston

The session will discuss enduring strategies and capital allocation during times of geopolitical and technological transition.

Mark Gebbia, Vice President of Environmental, Regulatory and Permitting, will participate in a panel entitled <u>Learnings from Methane and Flaring Reduction Programs in Oil & Gas</u> on Wednesday, March 20 at 8:30 a.m. CDT. It will cover lessons learned from the natural gas value chain when deploying technologies to reduce methane emissions and flaring.
