



Williams Sets February Dates for Clean Energy & Technology Expo and 2026 Analyst Day

TULSA, Okla.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Jan. 22, 2026-- Williams (NYSE: WMB) will host its [Clean Energy & Technology Expo](#) in Washington, D.C. on Monday, February 9, 2026. The Expo will focus on innovative solutions to deliver the reliable, affordable and clean energy needed to power the economies of the future. The Expo will bring together industry experts, innovators and policymakers to showcase how natural gas infrastructure, coupled with existing, new, and emerging technologies, are advancing energy security, affordability and emissions reductions.
